

MONDAY, MARCH 11 AND TUESDAY, MARCH 12 AT 7P IN THE CHURCH

The Paschal Mystery in the Psalms The psalms have always played a central role in the Church's worship of God, for they are God's own sacred words by which he teaches us how to pray. As we journey through Lent towards its culmination in the Paschal Triduum (Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter), we recall two psalms in particular recited by our Lord himself as his ministry reached its fulfillment.

Monday March 11: Psalm 136, The Last Supper, and the Eucharistic Revival Catholics are accustomed to thinking of the Eucharist as the Body and Blood of Christ that we receive at Mass - and that it certainly is. But the word literally means thanksgiving, and a close reading of Psalm 136 - a psalm of thanksgiving - should reignite in our hearts the attitude of grateful devotion that should characterize our celebration of every Mass.

Tuesday March 12: Psalm 22, Good Friday, and the Shroud of Turin Christians have always recognized in this Old Testament prayer a foretelling of the Passion; and strikingly, Psalm 22 was invoked by Jesus with his last precious breaths on the Cross. With the help of certain details from the Shroud of Turin, we will enter more deeply into this psalm, into our Lord's suffering, but also into his enduring hope.

A NOTE FROM FATHER 10 MARCH 2024

PARTICIPATE IN THE CENSUS TODAY! JESUS HIMSELF DID IT.

My Dear Friends,

For the past two weeks, we have been inviting you to participate in our Parish Census, giving reasons as to why it is important to do so. My invitation still continues especially today when we begin our actual Census exercise. Did you know that a census is so important that one of the most significant events in Salvation History, that involved God being ushered into our world as a child happened around a census? The Gospel of Luke connects the birth of Jesus to a "worldwide census" ordered by Augustus Caesar in which individuals had to return to their ancestral cities to be counted. Jesus' parents, Joseph, and Mary, had to travel about 90 miles from their home in Nazareth. Galilee, to Bethlehem, where Jesus was born. Yes, the birth of Jesus happened around a census, that's how important a census is.

Whereas the census during which our Savior was born might have had mundane motivations such as increasing taxes and building the military strength of the Roman empire, ours is far from that. As good Stewards, our Census is motivated solely by our desire to serve your spiritual and pastoral needs better. To understand the need for this better, we also pointed out that these last few years, we have gone through many transitions here in our Parish including the COVID 19 and multiple leadership transitions which have re-ordered our priorities significantly. As your new Shepherd, this has also offered me the unique opportunity to assess the real needs of our parish at this moment so as to address them effectively and realistically.

However, after the Census, in order to come up with a solid plan to address these needs, we shall be conducting a Survey to determine the real needs of our parish and the resources needed to meet them. This Survey will involve all those who participated in the Census in answering questions such as, what sets

Our Lady of Mt. Carmel apart, from the other parishes? What are the things we are doing well which need to be continued? What things no longer work for us? And, what are the new emerging needs of our parish?

So, as pointed out, beginning this weekend through mid -April 2024, we shall be conducting our Census. Please, once again, I ask you to participate, as I have been doing in various ways these past weeks. Your participation is not only important to me but most importantly to the success of these efforts.

Have a blessed Lenten Season and know that I love you!


